Turner Classic Movies (TCM) will celebrate the life and career of acclaimed comedic actor Gene Wilder, who lit up the funniest movies of the 1970s with an irresistible neurotic charm with a five film tribute on Thursday Sept. 29. Wilder, who passed away Sunday Aug 28 at the age of 83, was a leading man with a comic flair and frizzy hair known for teaming with Mel Brooks on the laugh-out-loud masterpieces *The Producers* (1968), *Blazing Saddles* (1974) and *Young Frankenstein* (1974) was also two-time Oscar nominee, starred as a quirky candy man in *Willy Wonka & the Chocolate Factory* (1971) and in four films alongside stand-up legend Richard Pryor.
