The former Minnesota Timberwolves, Boston Celtics and Brooklyn Nets star played 21 seasons in the NBA after being drafted fifth overall in the 1996 NBA Draft by the Timberwolves. Garnett - who became the first NBA player in 20 years to be selected directly out of high school - led Minnesota to eight consecutive playoff appearances and finished as the franchise's all-time leading scorer.

In 2007, Garnett was traded to the Celtics and immediately helped lead the team a championship. Garnett played six seasons in Boston, helping the team to the playoffs every year. Traded to the Nets in 2013, he spent just over one season apiece with Brooklyn and Minnesota before retiring last month.

He also won a Gold Medal as a member of the U.S. Men's National Team in the 2000 Olympics.
