Turner Sports and CBS Sports announce tip times and commentator teams for the Regional Finals of the 2018 NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Championship on Sunday, March 25, on CBS and via NCAA March Madness Live. Texas Tech/Purdue will take on Villanova in the first game at 2:20 p.m. ET, followed by Duke playing Kansas at 5:05 p.m. The *Road to the Final Four* pregame show will begin the day's action at 1 p.m. with host Greg Gumbel and analysts Charles Barkley, Clark Kellogg and Kenny Smith.
